3. Correspondence

- COVID re-opening protocols in the Club House Compliance Concerns? Compliance with the COVID protocols appears to be going well. Light attendance at Club noted by all. Family nights slow with 3 to 4 people attending prescheduled.

6. New Business

- Fall Return to Play considerations
 - i. JOP Discussed options to re-introduce JOP in the fall. Richard felt it would work as we have rarely had more than eight JOP members in past years.
 Deferred for Roger's consideration and input but will aim for the September restart. Consideration max 10 plus 2 coaches parents wait outside.
 - ii. Harvest Moon Discussed options within current "Return to Play" protocols if we may be in a position to proceed with the Harvest Moon shoot scheduled for October 4th. Current restrictions would limit participants to Club Members only and max out at 50 people on site (Coordinators and Archers combined). Lance not present for input but possibility to proceed supported by all members in attendance. Work Party to prepare if current situation remains stable Set for September 19th at 9:00 am
