Motions to be discussed

Motion # 1 – (Richard Browning) – Motion to reopen discussions regarding the “Stepped” Membership fee's structure replaced last AGM by the current – full fee until September – format. Following September 1st, in the current fee schedule, all new Memberships paid in full would continue paid membership for the following year. No prorated amounts are applicable either prior to September 1st or following September 1st.

Motion # 2 – (Richard Kennett) - Motion to include Richard Browning and Bruce Peters as Lifetime Members of the Cowichan Bowmen for their years of dedicated service to our Club.

- Richard Browning has been an active Member, Director, Provincial Judge and Volunteer for over 15 years with the Club and is typically one of the first to raise his hand to manage special functions wherever they may occur. He has also maintained our lawns on the target field for many years as a lead on that team. As President – I fully support Richard in becoming a Lifetime Member

Additionally, funding for the construction of weather roofing, to be attached to the moveable target frames, to assist in protecting the new targets. Approximate total cost \$5000.00

Motion # 4 - (Sara Gibb) - Motion to open a new account for the purpose of tracking and accounting for costs and profits associated to an expansion of the gaming format during our larger shoots. A return to the raffle format has been requested which will require a higher degree of accounting for ticket sales and prize purchases and donations. The establishment of a dedicated “Gaming Account” will assist in this endeavor.

Motion # 5 - (Sara Gibb) - Conditional on the outcome of the 1st Motion to be discussed and only if a return to the “Stepped” fee schedule is once again in place. Motion to raise the Registration Membership Fees by an amount determined during discussion to ensure similar working capital is obtained through Memberships each year, as well to offset any additional accounting that may be required to properly managed the “Stepped Fee” structure.
